



## Transportation Plan

Ralston Public Schools shall provide transportation as required under state statute.

**Nebraska Statute 79-611:** Resident students who reside greater than 4 miles from their school of current attendance are eligible for transportation and may receive district transportation or paid mileage upon request. Further, students who are homeless shall be provided transportation as required by law.

**Nebraska Administrative Code 92 NAC 51:** Requires special education transportation be provided to children with disabilities according to the child's Individualized Education Program (IEP) or Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP). Also eligible to receive transportation are resident students with recognized disabilities that have transportation identified as a necessary accommodation through the IEP.

**Option Enrollment Students:** May qualify for transportation based on state statute 79-241. In the statute, it says option students who meet the eligibility requirements and reside within the boundaries of transportation can be placed on a transportation route to and from school upon request. Option students residing outside of the boundary may choose transportation to a collection site, or to the closest stop within the transportation boundaries.
