

## Need to Know: Yellow Instructional Level

(Updated: July 23, 2020)



This document provides additional facts on certain topics from the Yellow Instructional Level of the Ralston Public Schools' Return to Learn Protocol. The District will follow guidelines as determined from the CDC, Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services and the Douglas County Health Department. All details listed below are subject to change before and during the 2020-2021 school year in response to the COVID-19 virus.

<p><b>Additional Safety Measures</b>  <i>(All of the enhanced health and safety measures from the Green Instructional Level will still be enforced as well as the following.)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● No visitors will be allowed in our buildings.</li> <li>● Random temperature checks</li> <li>● Lunch/breakfast in classrooms or limited group size in cafeterias</li> <li>● Staggered hallway movement</li> <li>● No out of state travel</li> <li>● Limited in-state travel &amp; field trips</li> <li>● Limited assemblies/pep rallies</li> </ul>
<p><b>Calendar</b>  <i>(coming soon)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● A Yellow Instructional Level calendar is being finalized and will be communicated to families outlining the days each group reports to school. This calendar will be month to month. The new month's calendar will be published in the last week of each month.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Instruction</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Students will have face-to-face instruction while at the buildings and "on your own" or "independent learning" while at home. The amount of work students will have to do at home will take up about the same time as if they were actually at school.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Pre-K</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Pre-Kindergarten students will be combined into groups of 10 to 15 students and will go to school every</li> </ul>

	<p>day of the week. Daily dismissal time will be 2:00 pm. Pre-Kindergarten families, more information will be coming soon.</p>
<b>Schedule</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students will attend school every other day on a modified schedule. This schedule includes staggered arrival and dismissal times.</li> <li>• The first day of school will still be Tuesday, August 11th. This will be a Red Square Day. Wednesday, August 12th will be a Blue Triangle Day. This applies to students in grades kindergarten through twelfth-grade.</li> </ul>
<b>Student Groups</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Our student population will be divided into two groups. The Red Squares (A Day) and the Blue Triangles (B Day).</li> <li>• Students within the same family or who live at the same residence will attend school on the same day.</li> </ul>
<b>Technology</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Distribution of technology devices will be possible for all students in grades kindergarten through twelfth-grade.</li> <li>• High School students will receive Chromebooks at Check-In. Middle School students will receive Chromebooks during the first week of school. District officials are developing a distribution plan for kindergarten through sixth-grade students. More information will be communicated from your building principal.</li> </ul>
